

## Coronavirus (COVID-19) Recovery Premium and School Led Tutoring 2021-2022

This statement sets out how Eden Park Academy intends to use its Recovery Premium and School Led Tutoring Funding

**Intent: To narrow gaps in reading exacerbated by the Covid-19 pandemic; to re-engage pupils through music**
