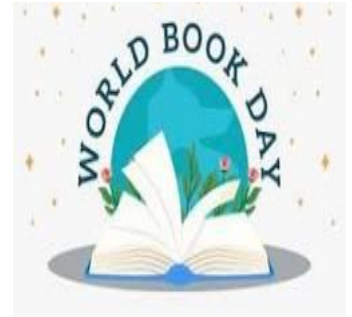

Dear Parents and Carers,

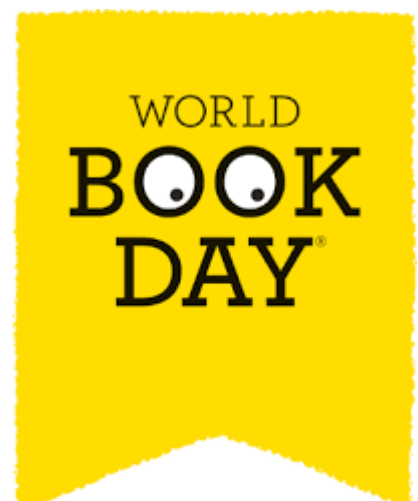

Headlice Prevention

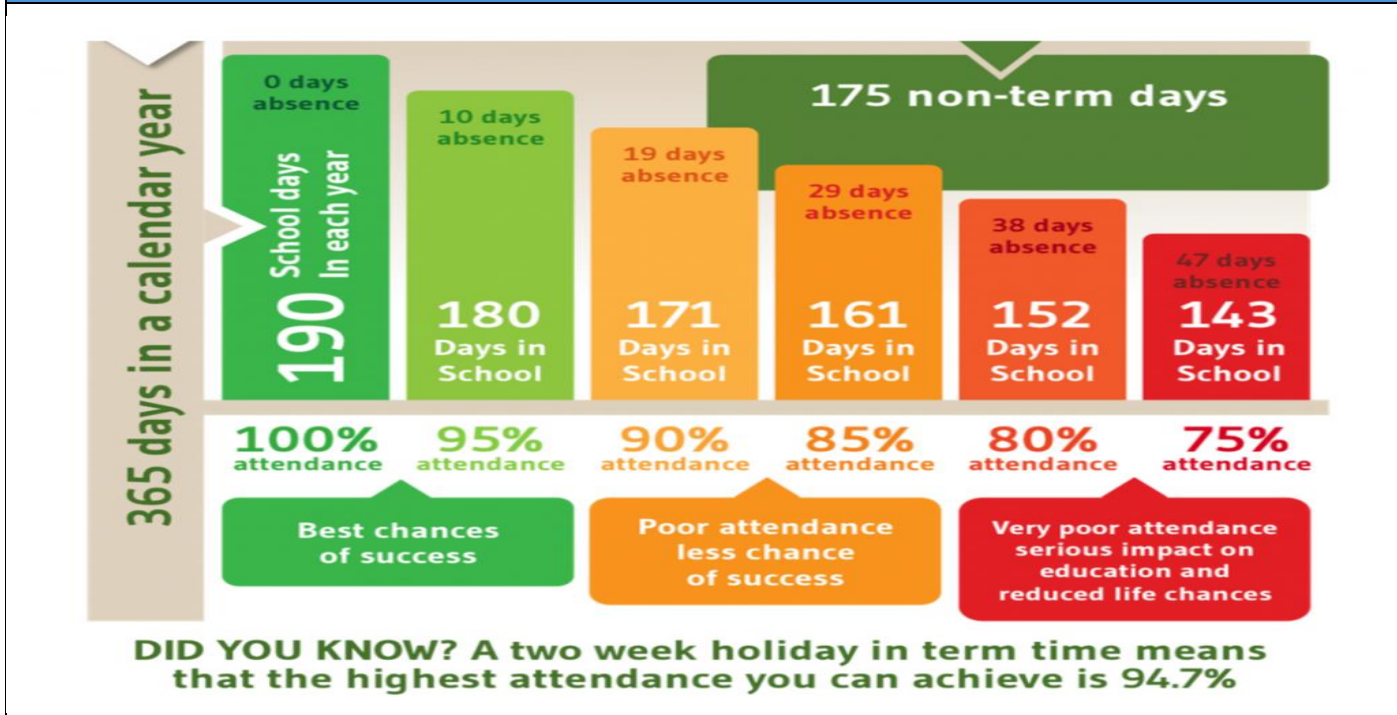
