Free School Meal Applications



You can apply via Devon Citizens
Portal. Select the link for Free School
Meals. It will ask you a few questions
about your income and once you have
answered the questions it will give you
an instant response of whether you
are entitled to Free School Meals or
not. If you are it will give you a code,
this needs to be either emailed or
shown to the Office

Even if your child is in Reception to Year 2 and gets a universal free school meal, it is still important to apply as this is additional funding.

Applications can now be made for a primary school place for entry in Reception class in September 2025. You must apply for your child's place by **15th January 2025.**



Fully Funded (FREE) NCFE | CACHE Courses available in levels 1 & 2 with fully funded progressions available for level 3 - starting on 27th January. We run ONLY in term time and not during half term / end of term periods. Enrol by Wednesday 22nd January!

This is a six-week course, available in level 1 & 2, with live webinar sessions running from 9:30am - 11:30am, with a 1 hr lunch break, followed by a second 1.5 hr session from 12:30-2pm.

All you need is access to the internet and a laptop or tablet. These courses are fully funded by the ESFA (Education Skills Funding Agency).

If you are earning less than £23,500 per year or claiming benefits (including Universal Credit, JSA, ESA, PIP, Income Support, Housing Benefits, carers allowance or any type of Tax Credit including Child Tax Credit) you are eligible for a funded place.
