Year 2 to Year 6 have their disco from 5pm to 6pm.




Spaces are £3 each and includes unlimited squash and a heart cookie! Please pay in advance at reception if your child would like to go!


All parents will receive an attendance letter this week regarding term-time holiday warnings. This is a government letter that is sent to all parents twice a year.
